RESOLUTION ACCEPTING AND APPROVING EXECUTION OF 2025-2027 HIGHWAY COLLECTIVE BARGAINING AGREEMENT

The following Resolution was duly presented for consideration by the Town Board:

WHEREAS, through its Steward in August of 2024, the Highway Association, as a recognized employee bargaining unit, requested bargaining to update the existing Collective Bargaining Agreement (the “Agreement”) and cover a new term, January 1, 2025 to December 31, 2027; and

WHEREAS, representatives of the bargaining unit and the Town duly met and bargained the terms, conditions of employment in, and the final language of such proposed “Agreement”, and the parties tentatively agreed upon the final form of said Agreement; and
